

2024 BALLOT GUIDE



Vote before 7 p.m. on November 5, 2024

We evaluate every statewide ballot issue to determine its impact on rural Latino immigrants. These are our recommendations for 2024.

STATEWIDE BALLOT ISSUES

YES

Amendment 79 Abortion Rights

Creates a constitutional right to abortion and repeals ban on use of public funds for abortion care.

NO

Amendment 80 Redefines right to education

Supported by right-wing groups, this proposed amendment could redirect public funding to private schools, with grave consequences to an already underfunded public education system.

YES

Amendment G Disabled Veterans

Expands eligibility of current property tax exemption for disabled veterans.

YES

Amendment H Judicial Discipline

Creates oversight for misconduct of judges.

NO

Amendment I Deny Pre-Trail Bail

Denying pre-trial bail to a group of people does not uphold the principle of due process and will take us backwards in criminal justice reform.

YES

Amendment J Marriage Equality

Changes definition in the Constitution to allow for same-sex marriage because no group of people should be denied fundamental human rights.

YES

Amendment K Election Deadlines

Changes the signature deadline for initiative and referendum signature gathering.

NO

Proposition 127 Prohibit Trophy Hunting

While we do oppose "trophy" hunting, this proposition creates a new class 2 misdemeanor violation with mandatory jail time, which will needlessly increase the prison population.

NO

Proposition 128 Parole Eligibility

Supported by right-wing groups, this proposition would needlessly lock up people and benefit private prisons, costing tax-payers millions.

YES

Proposition 129 Veterinary Associates

Creates new associate profession to practice under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian.

NO

Proposition 130 Extra Police Funding

Supported by right-wing groups, this proposition would force the state to redirect funding away from public education, health services and other programs every year to give to police.

NO

Proposition 131 Change Election Process

Supported by millionaires, this proposition would make our election system more confusing and benefit the wealthy, not working people.

YES

Proposition JJ Retain Sports Betting Tax

Allows state to keep sports betting tax revenue above an amount to support water projects.

YES

Proposition KK Firearms and Ammo Tax

Adds excise tax on the manufacture and sale of firearms and ammunition to support victims services.
